We tapped into the Reserve Fund in late September to balance the contributions and expenses. We did not have to tap into the Reserve Fund in October to meet expenses.

Year to date we are matching our contributions to our expenses, but that is occurring because our actual expenses are about \$20,000 less than budgeted.

On 1/1/2024 the Mortgage Fund had a balance of \$107,674. Contributions have been made to this Fund throughout the year, and we have made the \$10,273 monthly payments. On 10/1/2024 the Mortgage Fund had a balance of \$72,546.

Our Stewardship campaign culminates on November 3, and we will report those results shortly thereafter.

November and December will also be 2025 Budget Planning, and we will keep you informed about that process. Our Congregational Budget Discussion will be on Sunday January 12, 2025, and the Congregational Annual Meeting will be January 26, 2025.
