The first quarter is done, and St. James has had a great first 3 months of 2025.

We've had great worship, education, evangelism, and hospitality activities, events, and services.

The second quarter looks exciting with Easter, Pentecost, graduations, and visits from our friends from Tanzania! Summer Camp attendance and a variety of summer hospitality events will also occur in the coming months.

All these things happen because of your generosity of time, talent, and treasure.

We have received over 35% of our expected contributions in the first 25% of the year! Expenses have been at or below budget (i.e. lower than expected snow removal and insurance expenses).

Over the past several months the SE Iowa Synod has hosted multiple Zoom meetings for Treasurers. I've attended those meetings and learned a number of things, mostly that the financial practices St. James has in place meet or exceed the accounting, safeguarding, and auditing guidelines suggested by the Synod and National ELCA. These practices have been in place for many years thanks to the expertise of prior Treasurers and Council Members.
